



### **THE NEW CONWAY NAMED AS CARDIFF'S ONLY ENTRY INTO MICHELIN'S 'EATING OUT IN PUBS' GUIDE 2011**

The new Conway, on Conway Road in Pontcanna, has received the highest accolade in the pub world by being named as the only Cardiff pub to gain entry into the 'Eating Out In Pubs' guide 2011, compiled by Michelin. It is the gastro pub's second year to feature in the guide and recognition of the friendly service, imaginative menus and extensive list of ales and wines available.

The guide recognises over 500 pubs across the UK, and each entry features an in-depth description and colour photograph, with information on typical dishes and specialities, real ales served and interesting wine lists. The Conway is only one of 21 entries for Wales, including the likes of The Hardwick at Abergavenny, The Foxhunter at Nant-y-Derry, and The Bell at Skenfrith.

The pub, which is owned by Knife & fork Food Ltd, opened in November 2008 following an extensive refurbishment. Menus change regularly according to seasonality, and many dishes boast fresh produce from local allotments.

Serge Luceau, Director for Knife & Fork Food, goes onto say, "We are absolutely delighted to be named in the guide for the second year running. It is always nice to be recognised in the trade by the guides. We want to offer our customers good food, local produce and the best ales and wines. We're obviously doing something right!"
